



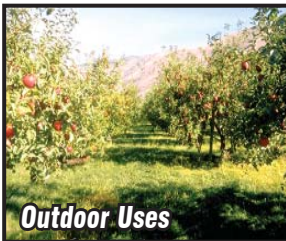
Mist Netting

For the Humane Capture of Small Birds and Bats



Nixalite Mist Netting

- 8ft x 30ft, 2-ply nylon
- 3 pouch construction
- 8 mounting loops



Outdoor Uses

- Plant nurseries
- Courtyards, vineyards
- Orchards, gardens



Indoor Uses

- Retail stores, malls
- Warehouses, attics
- Parking garages, etc



Conservation

- Tagging, banding, etc
- Species sampling

Nixalite Mist Netting:

Made from UV resistant 2-ply nylon cord. Each net has 3 interior and one perimeter reinforcement strands. It features a 3-pocket design with 4 mounting loops at each end.

- 8ft x 30ft (2.4M x 9M) mist net.
- 11/16" knotted diamond mesh.
- UV resistant 2-ply nylon strands.
- Standard 3-pouch construction.
- 8 HD mounting loops for fastening.
- Lightweight, only 4 oz. for 240 sq. ft.
- Used properly, Nixalite's mist netting is harmless to small bird and bat species.

Applications:

For the humane capture and relocation of small birds and bats. Ideal for indoor and outdoor applications. Use in malls, stores, plant nurseries, courtyards, warehouses, etc. Used for population sampling, tagging, tracking or otherwise testing the numbers and health of small bird and bat species.

Keys to Success:

Proper placement and continuous attention are keys to a successful installation. Qualified personnel must always be present to quickly release all captured birds or bats.

General Guidelines

- Please note that this is a basic guide for mist nets. Your application may be different and require different steps and or materials. If you have any questions, contact Nixalite of America Inc.

Observation:

Find the path that birds or bats use to enter or exit the area. Note the time when they are most active. Plan to position the net across the observed flight path during the most active time of day.

Support Posts:

Posts are the most common method of supporting the mist nets. Make sure posts are long enough and strong enough to hold the mist net directly in the observed flight path. Maximum post diameter is 1-1/4".

Set Up:

Set up is unlike other bird nets in that mist nets are set up 'loose'. This cushions the bird or bat when it hits the net. At each end, thread

a post through the 4 mounting loops. Space the loops on the post so each of the 3 pouches has a 'pocket' of net (3 to 5 inches deep) at the bottom of the pouch. This is where most birds or bats end up after flying into the netting.

Important:

It is the responsibility of the user to check local, state and federal laws or restrictions regarding the capture of any wildlife using mist netting. DO NOT use mist nets to capture protected, threatened or endangered species.

Nixalite guarantees the quality of the mist netting. We DO NOT guarantee that you will catch anything. Effective mist netting use takes careful planning, knowledge of the target species and being in the right place at the right time to get the desired results.
